



HOW TO INSTALL YOUR FONTS

DESKTOP USE

(INSTALLATION ON MAC/WINDOWS)



Download the .zip file from the site, saving it in a folder



Extract the files from the archive with the shell (right click) or with software (e.g. Winzip, Unzip)



If you have a previously installed a trial version of the font(s), **de-install the trial font files.**



Macintosh: Add the font using the System Font Book.



Windows: Open Control Panel and double-click the Fonts folder. Go to the "file" menu and select "Install new font". Browse to the location where you extracted the .zip file, and click OK.



Restart your system



In our typeface download page you get access to both **.otf (postscript opentype)** and **.ttf (truetype opentype)** versions of the typeface. They are virtually identical for most basic uses and both contain any opentype feature enclosed in the typeface. We sometimes offer non-opentype ttf versions, labelled "compatibility packs" (only useful if you're using very old operative systems or software).

WEB CSS USE

(DEPLOYMENT ON WEB SERVER)

If you have bought a web license a zip file with the webfont formats will be downloadable from you license page.



Download the .zip file from the site, saving it in a folder



Extract the files from the archive with the shell (right click) or with software (e.g. Winzip, Unzip)



Copy the relevant font files to your online filesystem



and include correct instructions in your css files / cms (e.g. Wordpress)



We provide a basic webpack containing **ttf, woff, svg and eot.**

We are in the process of discontinuing svg format and to implement woff2.

If you need other formats, or want to reduce the character set to optimize loading times, you are allowed to use online tools like

fontquirrel.com/tools/webfont-generator

to optimize our font files to webfont formats.
